Once you have completed your writing, **edit** your work. Use the checklist below to help you.

| Editing Checklist | |
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| 1. Clarity Read your work, asking yourself 'Will this make sense to another reader?' 'Find any confusing spots and rewrite them so that they are clearer and easier to read. | |
| 2. Punctuation Have you included all of the important punctuation? Check over and correct any missing punctuation. Check that you avoid using and or then over and over again. | |
| 3. Spelling Is your spelling correct? Circle words that feel like they may not be correct and try them again. Ask for help if you need to. | |
| 4. Improve Can your writing be improved in any way? Have you made sure you have included lots of description in your writing? Can you think of even better vocabulary to use? | |



Once you have edited your work, write your final draft in your best handwriting with all of the corrections. You might like to write your published piece in the style of a postcard or alternatively type it up on the blog.

Then, write your first name on your work and upload a photo of it. I will add it to the gallery, where I can give you feedback.
