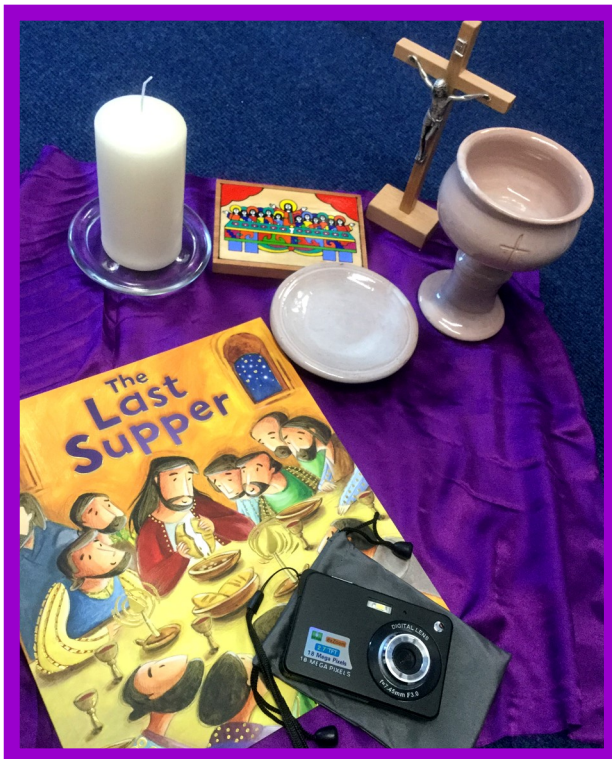
The Last Supper



To help us remember the Last Supper we would like to invite you to share our special Lent box with your family at home.

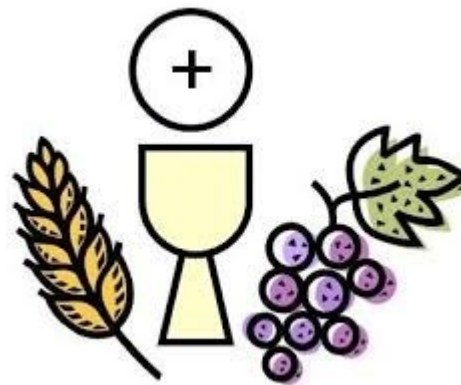
This is to help us remember the importance of the Last Supper.

- * You could use the chalice and the paten to re-enact the Last Supper.



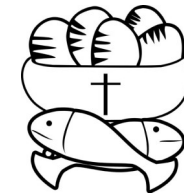
A prayer to say when the candle is lit and you have taken time to reflect:
