Task

Your task today is to find out about classic dishes that come from different countries. You may like to choose your own country that you or your family members are from and tell us more about the food dishes you eat. Alternatively, you can choose a completely different country!

Example:

Country: Wales

Food Dish: Cawl

Description: Cawl is a traditional Welsh soup or broth. Most common recipes are with lamb or beef with leeks, potatoes, swedes and carrots. It is perfect for cold winter nights.

Other traditional food: Welsh cakes (I love these and make them regularly!), Bara Brith which is like a fruit cake and Welsh Rarebit which is melted Welsh cheese on toasted bread.

Now it is your turn. Set out your answers like mine, so we know which country you have chosen. Try to choose different dishes so we can find out about lots of new foods!
