
Praying the Rosary with the Diocese of Westminster The Nativity of The Lord : Friday 10th July

Joseph and Mary go to Bethlehem to comply with the decree of Caesar Augustus.


We are all on a journey. We ask God to accompany us on our path.

Mary and Joseph must have been worried. We ask God to relieve any worries and fears that we have.



May we worship the Lord Jesus like the first people who heard about his birth.






