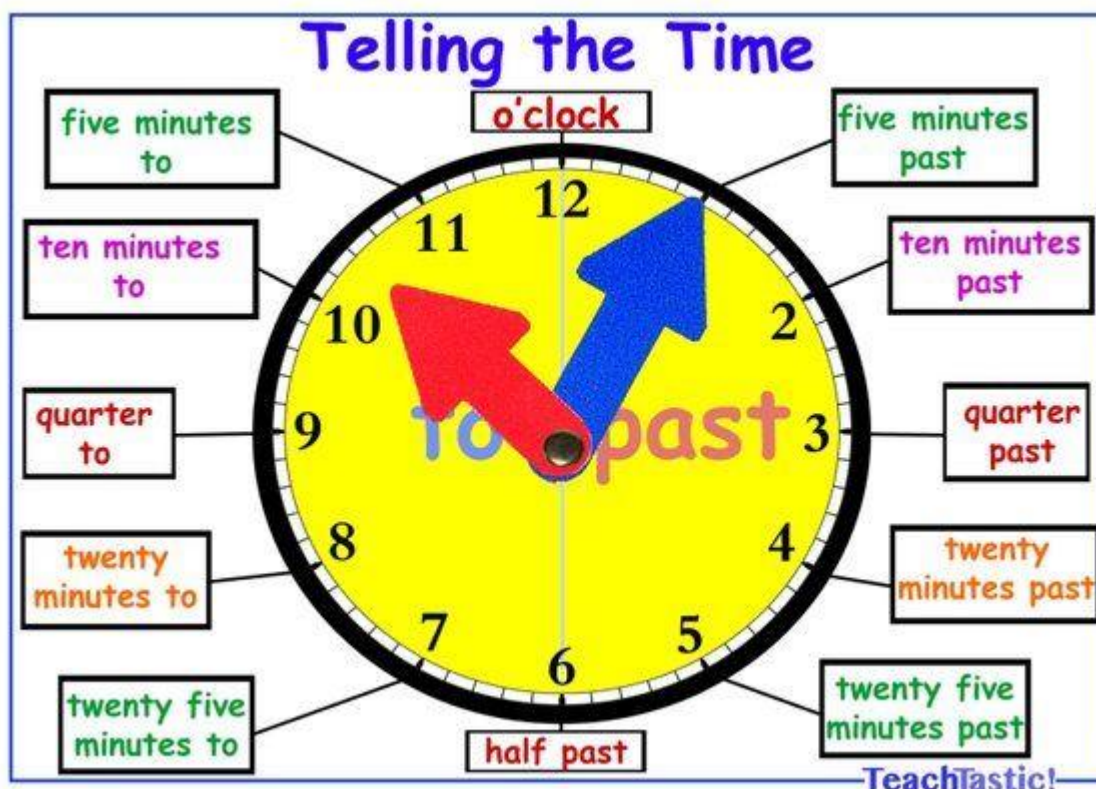
Chapter 9: **Time**
