This task will include a big question to reflect on about our topic 'Pentecost'.



Last week in Religious Education, we learnt about the promise of the Holy Spirit and the coming of the Holy Spirit. We shared ideas about what we would tell others if we had experienced the Holy Spirit during Pentecost.

The Church celebrates Pentecost

The Church itself is part of the Pentecost story. Each year, Christians remember and celebrate the coming of the Holy Spirit, the new energy, the new power that he gives to the friends of Jesus.

PENTECOST

At Mass today the priest wears red vestments. Many churches put up special banners and symbols of the Holy Spirit to remind everyone of the gifts of the Spirit. The Church celebrates the fulfilment of Jesus' promise that the Holy Spirit would guide and help his disciples to understand all that he had taught them.



Big Question

What gifts do you think the Holy Spirit brings to us?

Jesus promised that the Holy Spirit would guide and help his disciples to understand all that he had taught them.

Think carefully about what *types of gifts* the Spirit can bring to us when we call upon it.

Example: Wisdom, the Holy Spirit can bring us wisdom when we need it, to guide us in our decisions and our thoughts.
