A story for Reception

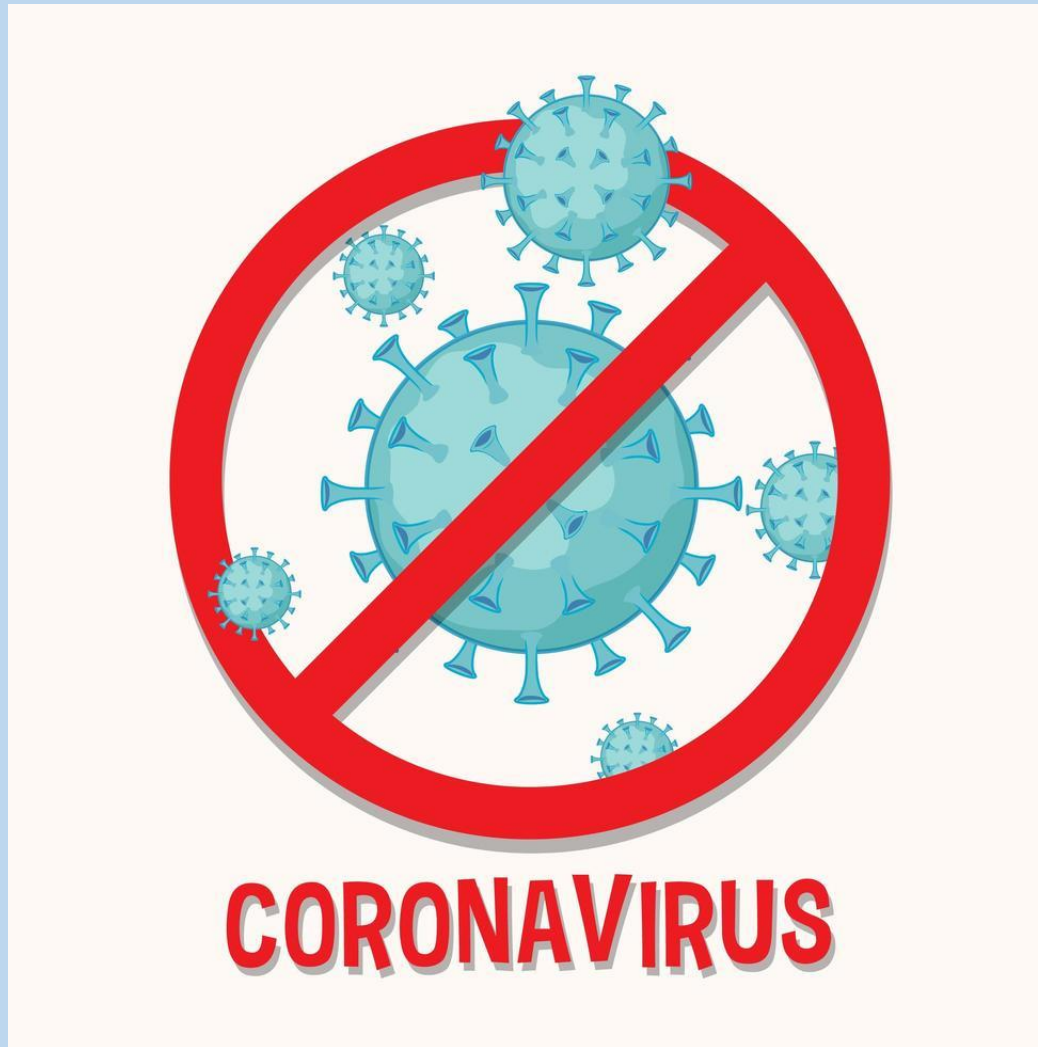




My school has been closed because of coronavirus.



We all had to stay at home to keep everyone safe.



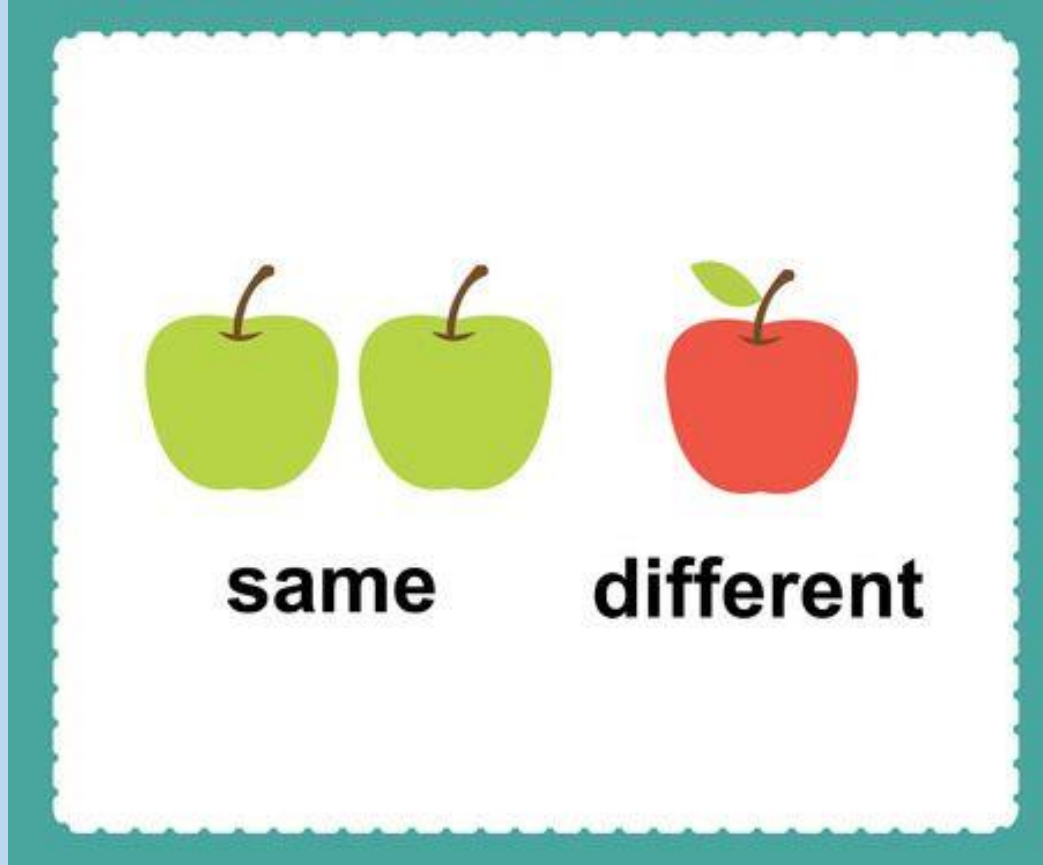
The virus is now not spreading as fast as it was.

Now it is safe for everyone to come back to school!



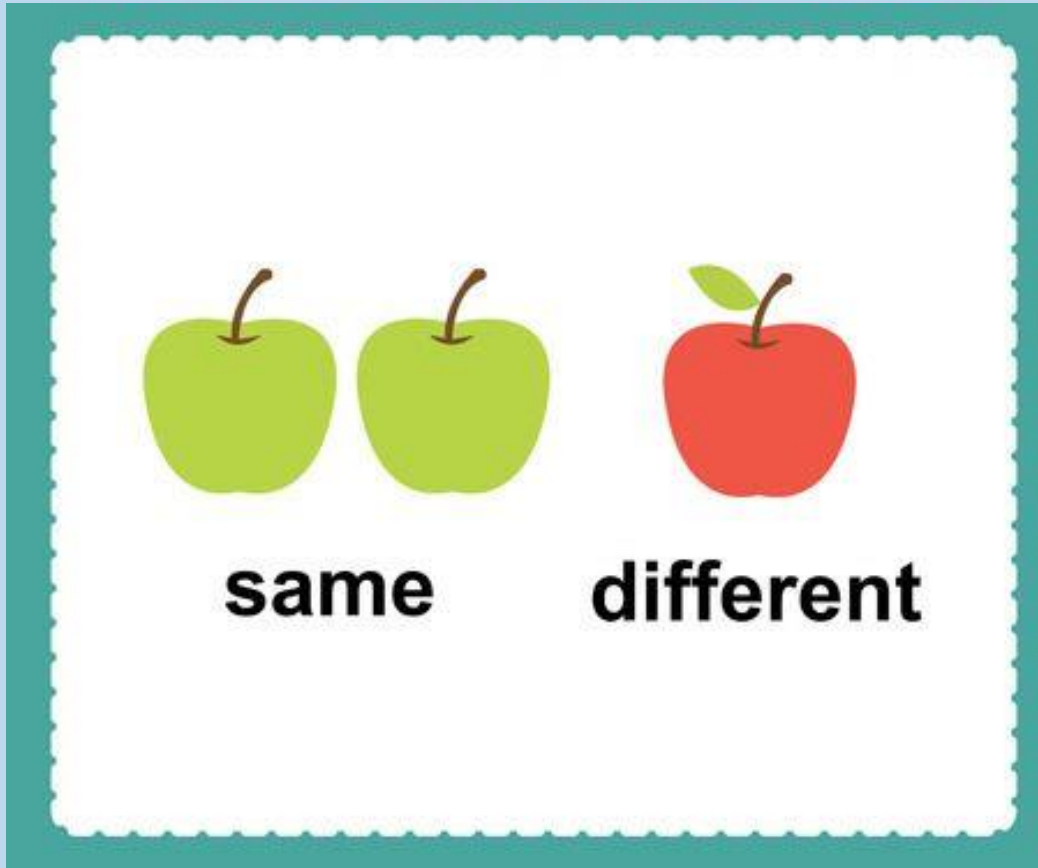
Some things will be the same as before.

There will be lots of exciting new things to learn and activities to do.

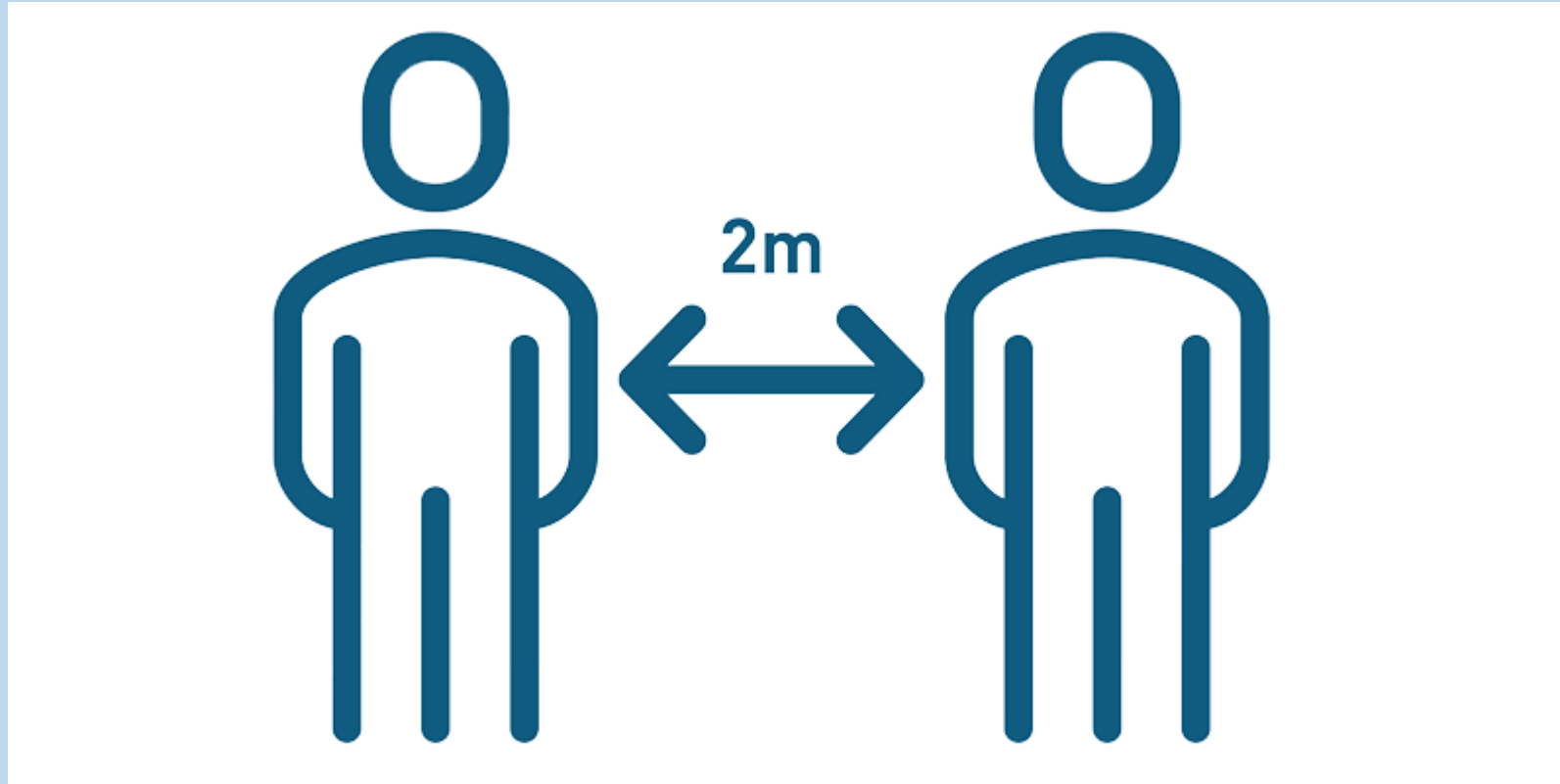
People Who Help Us

My bubble is made up of Reception and Nursery class and adults.



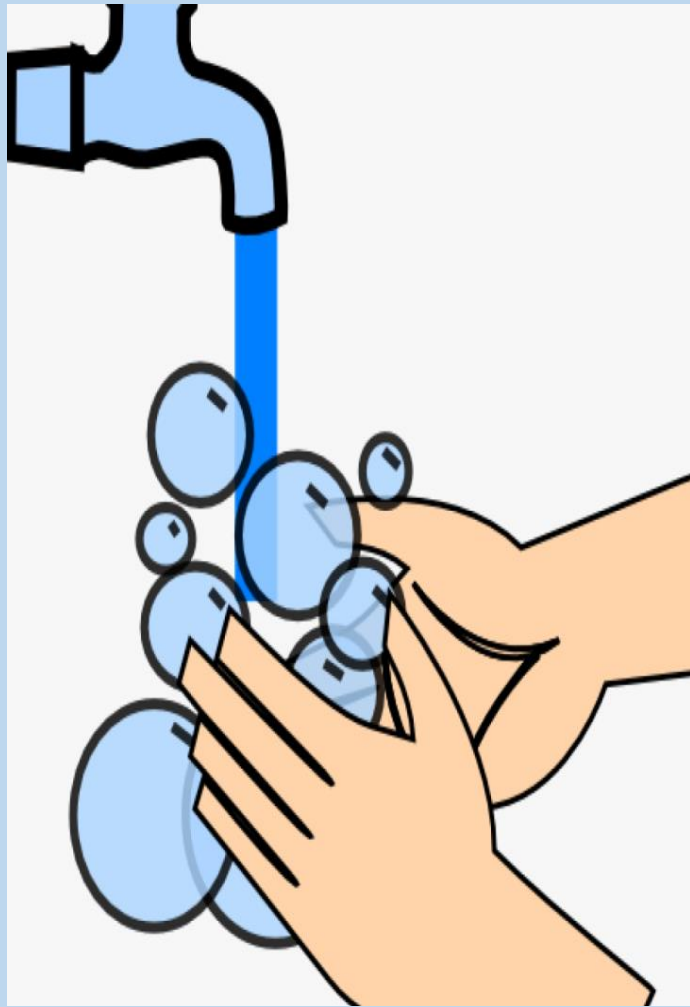
In my bubble, I can play with any of the children but the adults will keep 2m away from all of us to keep social distancing.



We can all use and share the toys, games and equipment with anyone in our bubble.



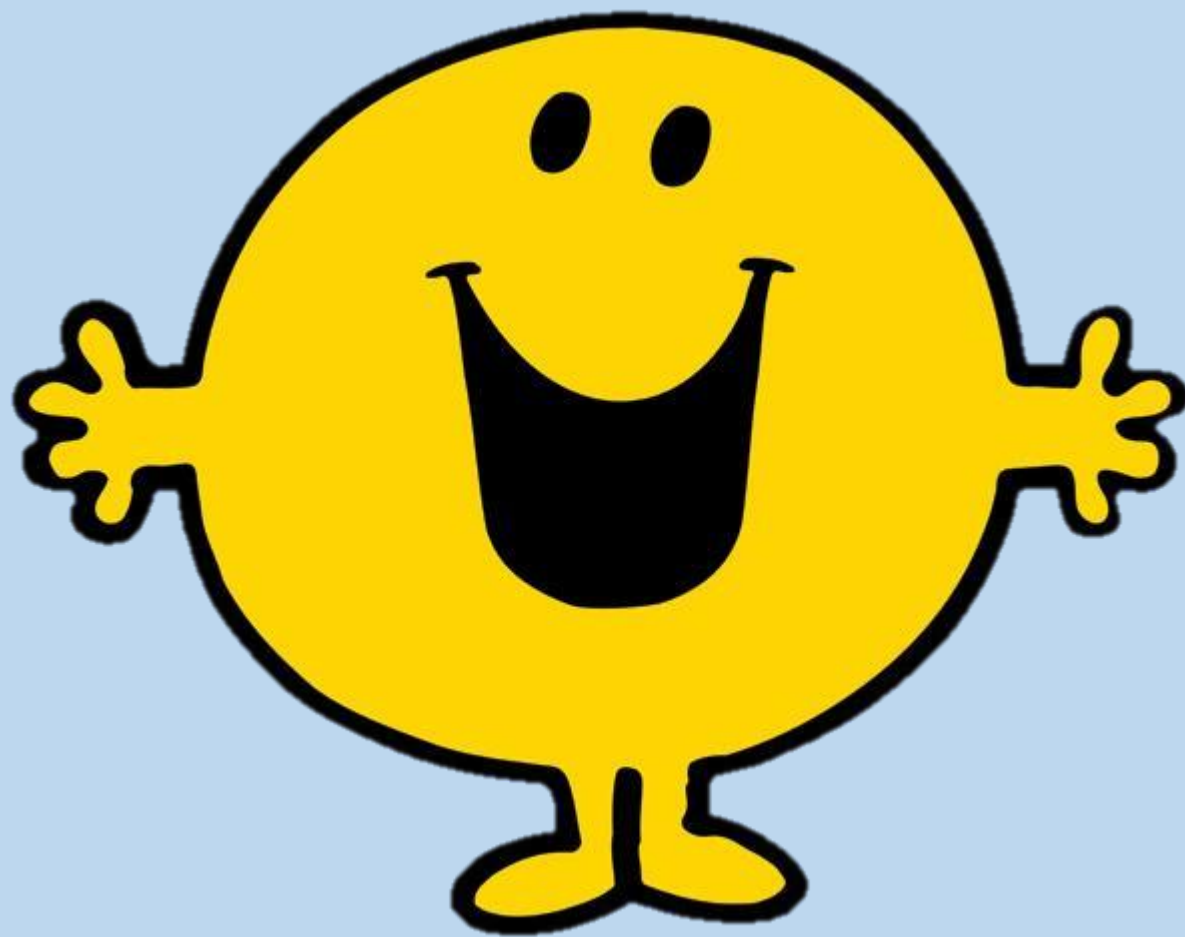
At lunch, we will have hot meals again. We have to bring our own water bottles to the hall for lunch.
