- Last year this event raised £60K which upgraded computers
- Help is needed in all areas such as, finding donations (street walkers), advertising, corporate emails, website maintenance, catalogue layout, collecting items, volunteering on the night and getting parents and the public (family and friends) to attend the Auction.
- Street walkers ask local business to donate item, vouchers, cash OR advertising.
- Advertising is the best money maker. It is a direct donation for the school and there is no limit.
- The donation forms and last year's catalogue will be available this Friday in the school office after approval
- There are 2 forms, a Parent form where you can donate a service, meal, or have personal relationship with a donor. There is also a business and advertising form
