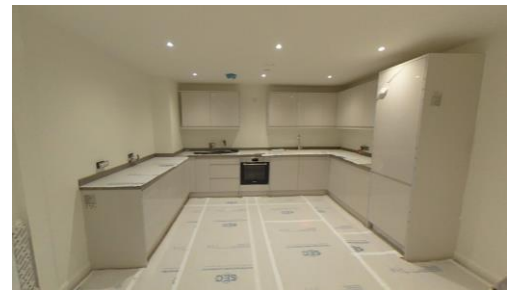
Dear Neighbour,

As 2022 draws to a close, the team at Marylebone Square would like to wish you all a Merry Christmas and a Happy New year.

It has been two years since we have commenced work on site and we have reached a number of milestones from completing the basement and concrete frame and the removal of one of the tower cranes.

Works are progressing to install the rooflight and internal works to build the apartments are fully underway. In the new year, we are hoping to reveal the works that have been ongoing behind the scaffold sheeting.

Next community liaison meeting will be held on 12th January 2023.

Upcoming works:

In the new year we are planning to remove the second tower crane and the hoist on the southern end.

There will also be some utility works and scaffold removal.

We will communicate the full plan associated with these works in the new year.

Site will be closed from 23rd December and we will return on the 3rd January 2023.
